Romans 8:26 -27 (NKJV) "Likewise the Spirit also helps in our weaknesses. For we do not know what we should pray for as we ought, but the Spirit Himself makes intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered. Now He who searches the hearts knows what the mind of the Spirit is, because He makes intercession for the saints according to the WILL OF GOD."

"Weaknesses" refers to when we don't know what to pray in a situation.

Jesus said this about the Holy Spirit's ministry:

John 16:12-13 (NIV) "I have much more to say to you, more than you can now bear. But when he, the Spirit of truth comes, he will guide you into all truth. He will not speak on his own; he will speak only what he hears, and he will tell you what is yet to come."

1 Corinthians 14:3 (NKJV) "But the one who prophesies speaks edification and exhortation and comfort to people."			
Acts 2:14- 17 (NIV) "Then Peter stood up with the Eleven, raised his voice and addressed the crowd. Fellow Jews and all of you who live in Jerusalem, let me explain this to you; listen carefully to what I say. These people are not drunk, as you suppose. It's only nine in the morning! Your sons and daughters will prophesy"
