Philippians 2:8-10 (NIV) "...He humbled himself and became obedient to death- even death on a cross! **Therefore God exalted him to the highest place** and gave him the name that is above every name, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God..."

1. KEEP GIVING MY _____ TO GOD

Isaiah 53:4 & 12 (NIV) "Surely he took up our infirmities and carried our sorrows, yet we considered him stricken by God, smitten by him, and afflicted... **Therefore I will give him a portion among the great, and he will divide the spoils with the strong**, because he poured out his life unto death, and was numbered with the transgressors, for he bore the sin of many, and made intercession for the transgressors."

Galatians 3:29 (NIV) "If you belong to Christ, then you are Abraham's seed, and **heirs** according to the promise."

Galatians 4:1-2 & 7 (NIV) "What I am saying is that, **as long as the heir is a child, they are no different from a slave**, although they own the whole estate. They are subject to guardians and trustees until the time set by their father... So you are no longer a slave, but a son or daughter; and since you are a son or daughter, God has made you also an heir."
