2. GIVING THANKS IS A _____ I MUST MAKE

Luke 17:15-16 (TPT) "One of them, when he saw he was healed, came back, praising God in a loud voice. He threw himself at Jesus' feet and thanked him- and he was a Samaritan."

In the Bible, thanksgiving and praise are connected and are often parallel in verses. (See Psalm 69:30 & Psalm 100:4)

To understand how thanksgiving is a matter of the will and involves action, let's look at the two Hebrew words in the Old Testament that mean to give thanks and then the five Hebrew words for praise.

THANKS

- "**Todah**" (Strong's #8426) literally means "extension of the hand" and is the word used in Israel today for ______
- "Yadah" (Strong's #3034) literally means to hold out the hand in reverence and also to throw _____

PRAISE

- "Halal" (Strong's #1984) means to be clear, shine, foolish or boast.
- "Shabach" (Strong's #7812) means to address in a loud voice.
- "Zamar" (Strong's #2167) means to touch the strings or instruments.
- "Barak" (Strong's #1288) literally is to kneel and means to bless.
- "**Tehillah**" (Strong's #8416) means laudation and praiseworthy and can speak of hymns.
