"**BLESSING**" (Strong's #2127, eulogeo) _____

The New Testament speaks about how God promised to bless and increase Abraham.

Hebrews 6:13-14 (NKJV) "For when God made a promise to Abraham, because He could swear by no one greater, He swore by Himself, saying, 'Surely blessing I will bless you, and multiplying I will multiply you.'"

God wants to bless and increase you too, but you have to receive the vision of God's promise for your life.

2. GOD WANTS TO GIVE YOU _____ AGAINST ALL OPPOSITION

You would think that after such a powerful promise of God of blessing and increase, that Abraham could just sit back and relax. But, instead, God immediately calls him into battle.

When God promises you blessings and increase for your life, you need to know that there will be _____

GENESIS 14:14-16 & 18-20 (NKJV)

"Now when Abram heard that his brother was taken captive, he armed his three hundred and eighteen trained servants who were born in his own house, and went in pursuit as far as Dan. He divided his forces against them by night, and he and his servants attacked them and pursued them as far as Hobah, which is north of Damascus. So he brought back all the goods, and also brought back his brother Lot and his goods, as well as the women and the people.

Then Melchizedek king of Salem brought out bread and wine; he was the priest of God Most High. And **HE BLESSED HIM** and said: Blessed be Abram of God Most High, possessor of heaven and earth; And blessed be God Most High, who has delivered your enemies into your hand.' And he gave him a tithe of all."

Abraham had a choice whether to engage in battle or not. You and I have a choice whether or not to engage in spiritual battle for our blessing too.
