# **ISAIAH 60:1-2 (NIV)**

"Arise, shine, for your light has come, and the glory of the Lord rises upon you. See, darkness covers the earth and thick darkness is over the peoples, but the Lord rises upon you and his glory appears over you."

"Arise" (Strong's #6965, quwm) means	
"Shine" (Strong's #215, owr) means	
The word "Halleluia" is from the Hebrew word "Halal" often translated	
and it means to shine.	

# **PSALM 34:2 (GNT)**

"I will praise [Hebrew Halal= to shine, boast, to make a show, to be clamorously foolish] him for what he has done; may all who are oppressed listen and be glad!"

## WHY I NEED TO PUT ON PRAISE:

## 1. PRAISE IS THE ATMOSPHERE GOD

Psalm 22:3 (MEV) "But you are holy, O you who **inhabits** the praises of Israel."

#### **EXAMPLE OF HOW GOD BLESSED OBED- EDOM**

1 Chronicles 13:13-14 (NIV) "He [David] did not take the ark of God to be with him in the City of David. Instead, he took it aside to the house of Obed-Edom the Gittite. The ark of God remained with the family of Obed-Edom in his house for three months, and the Lord blessed his household and everything he had."

1 Chronicles 15:25-26 and 28 (NIV) "So David and the elders of Israel and the commanders of units of a thousand went to bring up the ark of the covenant of the Lord from the house of Obed-Edom, with rejoicing. Because God had helped the Levites who were carrying the ark of the covenant of the Lord, seven bulls and seven rams were sacrificed... So all Israel brought up the ark of the covenant of the Lord with shouts, with the sounding of rams' horns and trumpets, and of cymbals, and the playing of lyres and harps."

God wants to bless you with his presence just like Obed-Edom was blessed.

You are called to praise God as a New Testament priest of God.

1 Peter 2:9 (NIV) "But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people belonging to God, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light."
