WHY SEEKING GOD IN PRAYER IS KEY TO MY BREAKTHROUGH

IN WHAT AREA OF MY LIFE DO I NEED A BREAKTHROUGH?

1. THE LORD IS THE LORD OF BREAKTHROUGH

MICAH 2:13 AMP “The Breaker (the Messiah) will go up before them. They will break through, pass in through the gate and go out through it, and their King will pass on before them, the Lord at their head.”

The Breaker is a king and his name is Jesus.

Jesus has all kingdom authority.

MATTHEW 28:18 “Then Jesus came to them and said, ‘All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me.’”

EXAMPLE: DAVID EXPERIENCED BREAK THROUGH

1 Chronicles 14:8-11 “When the Philistines learned that David had been made king of Israel, they mobilized all of their forces against him to attack and enslave him, but David heard the news and moved to his fortified place. Then the Philistine army moved in and spread out across the entire valley. So, DAVID SOUGHT THE LORD IN PRAYER. He asked, ‘Should I go fight these Philistines? Will you give them over to me?’ The Lord replied, ‘Yes, go ahead! You can certainly count on me to give you the victory! So David went out and defeated them. Then David said, ‘I watched the Lord BREAK THROUGH my enemies like a mighty flood.’ So he named the place Baal- Perazim (The Lord of the Breakthrough).”
