John 4:13-14 (JESUS) "Everyone who drinks this water will be thirsty again, but whoever drinks the water I give them will never thirst. Indeed, the water I give them will become in them a well of water springing up to eternal life."

When you are born again of the Spirit, you are satisfied and thirst no more.

WHEN WERE THE DISCIPLES "BORN AGAIN" OF THE SPIRIT? WHEN DID THEY BELIEVE IN JESUS AS SAVIOR?

John 20:21-22 "Again Jesus said, `Peace be with you! As the Father has sent me, I am sending you.' And with that he breathed on them and said, `Receive the Holy Spirit.'"

The Holy Spirit is able to dwell within believers after Jesus' blood was shed for all sin on the cross, restoring what was lost in the Garden of Eden.

Genesis 2:7 "The Lord God formed the man from the dust of the ground and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life and the man became a living being."

Acts 1:5 "For John baptized with water, but in a few days you will be BAPTIZED with the Holy Spirit."

"BAPTIZE" (Strong's #907, baptize) means ______

Acts 2:1-4 "When the day of Pentecost came, they were all together in one place. Suddenly a sound like the blowing of a violent wind came from heaven and filled the whole house where they were sitting. They saw what seemed to be tongues of fire that separated and came to rest on each of them. All of them were FILLED WITH THE HOLY SPIRIT AND BEGAN TO SPEAK IN OTHER TONGUES AS THE SPIRIT ENABLED THEM."

When you are baptized in the Spirit, you will thirst for more and will need to be continually filled with the Spirit each day.
