- 5. What will I be watching after?
- 6. What will I be occupying my time with?
- 7. How will provision be coming so I secure my future?

HOW PAUL FOUND HIS "ONE THING"

Acts 9:1, 3-6 "Meanwhile, Saul was still breathing out murderous threats against the Lord's disciples... As he neared Damascus on his journey, suddenly a light from heaven flashed around him. He fell to the ground and heard a voice saying to him, 'Saul, Saul, why do you persecute me?' 'Who are you Lord?' Saul asked. 'I am Jesus, whom you are persecuting,' he replied. 'Now get up and go into the city and you will be told what you must do.'"

Acts 9:9 "For three days he was blind, and did not eat or drink anything."

Acts 9:17-18 "Then Ananias went to the house and entered it. Placing his hands on Saul, he said, `Brother Saul, the Lord- Jesus, who appeared to you on the road as you were coming here- has sent me so that you may see again and be filled with the Holy Spirit.' Immediately, something like scales fell from Saul's eyes, and he could see again. He got up and was baptized."
